

Listening

- We think about 4 times as fast as we speak
- We listen for facts and skip over the details and begin thinking about how to respond.
- The average person listens with about 25% efficiency





Asking Questions

- Mentee has more information than the Mentor about solving that problem
- Key to change is not just knowing what to do, but the motivation to do it.
- Asking honors and shows that we value the other person.





Speaking The Truth in Love



Always be humble and gentle. Be patient with each other, <u>making</u> <u>allowance for each other's faults</u> <u>because of your love</u>. Make every effort to keep yourselves united in the Spirit, binding yourselves together with peace.

Now these are the gifts Christ gave to the church: the apostles, the prophets, the evangelists, and the pastors and teachers. Their responsibility is to equip God's people to do his work and build up the church, the body of Christ. This will continue until we all come to such unity in our faith and knowledge of God's Son that we will be mature in the Lord, measuring up to the full and complete standard of Christ. Then we will no longer be immature like children. We won't be tossed and blown about by every wind of new teaching. We will not be influenced when people try to trick us with lies so clever they sound like the truth. Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church. He makes the whole body fit together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole body is healthy and growing and full of love."

- Help people modify how they show up it would change lives






Crucial Conversations

- The way we act during conversations is largely defined by how we feel.
- How we feel is not a direct function of what we see and hear
- Before you experience an emotion you have to tell a story.

Principles of Crucial Conversations

- The vital behavior that enables the most positive outcome is candor.
- Make it Safe Create Mutual purpose
 - I care about their problems
 - I care about you
- Crucial conversations accelerate the building of trust between individuals
- Absolutely honest and absolutely respectful
